A pediatric nurse is on site to administer daily medications, and a pediatric oncologist is on call at all times.

Accommodations

Lodging at Camp Aldersgate (where Camp Hope is located) includes a heated retreat center and rustic waterfront cabins. Meals are served, and many songs sung, in a communal dining hall. The 300-acre site in North Scituate, Rhode Island, is home to woodlands, a waterfront with a sandy beach, playing fields, and a ropes course.
