## we are **Activists**

- Contributed to a 29% drop in the cancer death rate in the US since 1991, translating into 2.9 million fewer cancer deaths
- In all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and federally, the volunteers and staff of our nonpartisan advocacy affiliate, the American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network<sup>SM</sup> (ACS CAN), work to make cancer a top priority of public officials
- ACS CAN was instrumental in the passage of a bipartisan funding bill that **increased medical research funding at the National Institutes of Health by \$2.6 billion**, including a \$296 million increase for the National Cancer Institute
- More than 61% of the US population is covered by smoke-free laws, including 27 states that require 100% smoke-free workplaces, in large part because of ACS CAN's advocacy efforts

## we are a leader in transformational cancer Breakthroughs

- As the largest private nonprofit funder of cancer research, we have invested more than \$4.9 billion since 1946
- 49 researchers funded by ACS went on to win the Nobel Prize
- Confirmed the link between smoking and cancer and the link between obesity and death from breast, colorectal, liver, uterine, and other cancers
- Played a role in most of the recent cancer research breakthroughs

- More than 9.5 million free rides to treatment provided for cancer patients since 2005 through Road To Recovery®
- More than 6 million free nights of lodging through our Hope Lodge® communities
- Helped deliver more than 915,000 low- or no-cost cancer screenings to those in need
