- Wear your choice of:
 - a **team quarter-zip or polo** with a **CvC patch** on the sleeve.
Adhesive/Removeable CvC patch(es) will be provided to all NCAA DI head coaches as well as DII and DIII NABC member head coaches (more info below).
 - a **suit or sport coat**.
 - If you will be wearing a suit, please reach out to Anne Gmerek (anne.gmerek@cancer.org) to request a lapel pin for your head coach.
- **Customize your sneakers** via:
 - a professional shoe designer
 - DIY with colored sharpies (e.g. allow kids staying in a hospital the opportunity to design your shoes!)

Are you in? Here's the game plan:

- **DI Coaches** - 10 patches will be sent to each DI program to the attention of your head coach arriving between January 5-15.
- **DII/DIII Coaches** - 1 patch will be sent to each NABC member head coach arriving between January 5-15.
 - **IMPORTANT NOTE:** The package will have a CvC logo on the outside of the envelope. If you do not receive your patches by January 15, please reach out to anne.gmerek@cancer.org.
