Our Hope Lodge® program provided **267,000 nights of free lodging** to cancer patients and caregivers who traveled far from home for treatment. Volunteers help make their stay convenient and comfortable.

Volunteers for our nonprofit, nonpartisan advocacy affiliate – the American Cancer Society Cancer Action NetworkSM (ACS CAN) – advocate to ensure public officials at all levels make cancer a priority.



Nearly **150,000** petitions were delivered to Congress through the One Degree campaign, helping to restore **\$2 billion in cancer research funding** to the federal budget.



Advocates have worked for laws that keep work places, restaurants, and bars **smoke-free in 63 municipalities across the US.**
