American Cancer Society School vs Cancer REWARDS PROGRAMS

The school rewards program gives back to schools for their participation in Relay For Life by providing commonly used school supplies that are often in short supply. A school can pool their total fundraising dollars and choose to receive supplies in return for their fundraising efforts – a win-win for Relay For Life and your school.

The value of the Relay Rewards program is in direct proportion to the school’s total fundraising dollars. The American Cancer Society will give back 5% of the school’s

fundraising total in supplies. Schools choose what they want from the list, and the American Cancer Society orders and delivers the items to the school.

The supply list includes items such as crayons, hand sanitizer, tissues, glue sticks, copy paper, and dry erase markers.

The school team must raise a minimum of \$1,000 to qualify for participation. The chart below outlines fundraising totals and associated reward values.

Option #2: Reward your school by earning school supplies.

Team \$ Raised	\$1,000	\$2,000	\$2,500	\$5,000	\$7,500	\$10,000	\$12,500	\$15,000	\$20,000	\$25,000	\$30,000

Once a school raises at least \$1,000, then they can get back up to 5% in school supplies.
