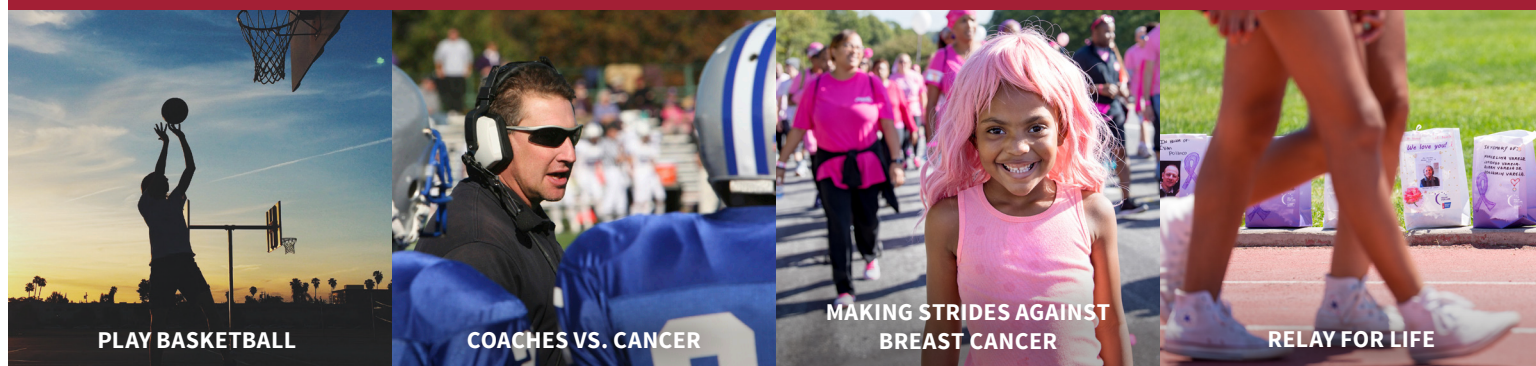


Have more fun with your next school fundraiser.
