Compared to White people, death rates in NHPPI people are:

75% higher for liver cancer 

2.5-3.3 times higher for cervical, stomach, and uterine corpus cancers 

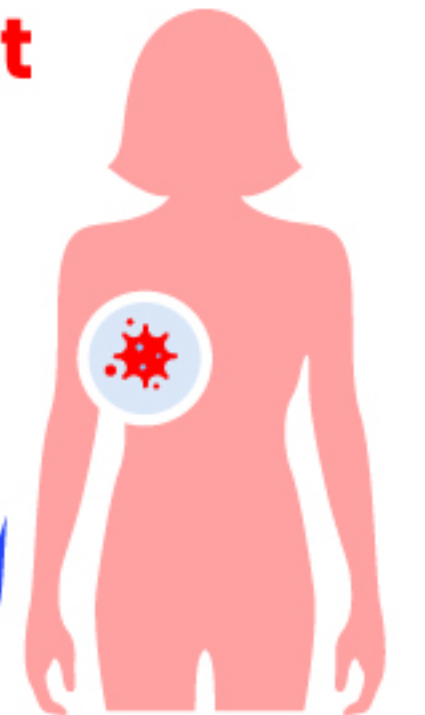


Cancer is the leading cause of death for Chinese, Filipino, Vietnamese, and Korean individuals



Lung cancer is the leading cause of cancer death in men in every Asian American and NHPPI ethnic group

Only about 50% of women who are Samoan, Tongan, Laotian, Guamanian, Hmong, or Pakistani are **diagnosed with breast cancer at an early stage** compared with **68% of White women** and **73% of Japanese women**
