Pilot Accelerator Award Letter of Intent (LOI) Instructions**

LOI Due Date: December 5, 2022, 11:59 PM EST

LOIs must be submitted electronically via proposalCENTRAL. Complete all required fields online and upload the required attachments.

Required Materials

1. Biosketches for all the PI and Team members
2. A description (3100 characters maximum, including spaces) of the study team, including the names and roles of each member. In addition, clinical trial number, title, and clinical trial PI need to be listed in the abstract.
3. An abstract (3100 characters maximum, including spaces) describing the background for the research plan, specific aims and hypothesis, study design, data analysis plan, and expected significance and impact. Include the required data elements, biospecimens, cohort exclusion/inclusion criteria, and any other resources needed from the approved clinical trial.

Note: Attachments must be uploaded as .pdf. References are not required, but can be uploaded as an attachment, if applicable.

After Submitting the LOI: LOIs will be reviewed, and invitation-to-apply decisions will be communicated to applicants via proposalCENTRAL by January 11, 2023.
